Identity

Our deeply interconnected social media environment world challenges our understanding of how we fit into the world and demands that we craft and project a personal brand online. We create media, or watch and share it, in order to express and perform our identities and affiliate ourselves with our communities.

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Affiliative

Affiliative videos target micro-audiences by reflecting viewers back to themselves, operating on a level of intimacy and recognition similar to in-jokes. These videos rely on recognizable phrases and situations, incentivizing viewers to share them to their networks to express their own identities. That affiliative videos cost little to produce allows them to target narrowly carved audiences that have not received such specialized attention in traditional media.

Daily Point of View

Social media platforms like Snapchat and Instagram empower their users to create and share photos and videos of daily life. The platforms' simple interfaces for sharing, viewing, and interacting with media make it possible for them to play a regular role in the way many communicate in their daily lives. When you snap a selfie, post a photo of your meal, or share a concert video with your friends, followers, or the public, you're telling a small story about yourself. In this way, Daily Point of View media resembles language more than art or cultural product.

Watch recent videos by Snapchat users from around the world in the Snap Map. Pinch to zoom and swipe to pan the map. Touch hot spots to view videos.

Loop Theater

Working within the constraints of the now-defunct social video platform Vine, users iterated on a unique kind of performance that relied on the 6.5-second loop as a defining formal element. Fast edits, absurd switches in logic, over-the-top acting, and nonsensical phrases and situations coined a number of memes and found the videos shared far outside their originating platform as Vine compilations. The strange, wacky humor was performed for friends and followers on the social network, an expression of self-identity.

Spotting

Spotters seek out and record videos of transportation technology including elevators, trains, buses, and airplanes, and share their finds online to express their passions with like-minded enthusiasts. Spotting videos are typically accompanied by highly specific details about manufacturers, models, and route numbers. Spotting is associated with autism spectrum disorder, though not all spotters are autistic. People on the autism spectrum grativate to predictable patterns and multi-sensory experiences, delving deeply into their subjects of interest.

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Vlog

The promise of the internet is the possibility that someone in the world is interested in what you have say. This access to audience offers an outlet for self-expression and companionship, and for some, a chance at stardom.

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Vlog

The vlog (a portmanteau of "video" and "blog") takes its ethos and namesake from the blog (short for "weblog") and is a personal, informal video directly addressed to the camera. When internet video was novel, vlogs were any kind of candid or journalistic endeavor published online. Today the vlog is regular, edited video documentation of a person's life, thoughts, opinions, and interests. Vlogs range from unscripted to poetic, but are marked by their casual focus on personal experience.


