Much of the appeal of the Structural Remix is creative labor made visible.

These videos are often a matter of pride, allowing a community to creatively show off their company, school, or hometown and its uniqueness and creativity. ## Songification

Musicians have long manipulated found sound to turn non-traditional objects or events into musical elements. The proliferation of tools like autotune and video editing software has made this effort more accessible and spawned a number of highly popular approaches. Songification videos tap the vast reservoir of source material available online, finding rhythm and melody in unexpected places to create humorous, critical, nostalgic, or sublime musical remixes.

## Challenge

Challenge videos depict participants engaging in unusual or challenging feats in order to participate in a popular collective phenomenon. These challenges are short, replicable templates for interactivity that offer participation on an achievable scale. The videos, while usually unremarkable on their own, compose something noteworthy in aggregate, and their growing popularity entices more participants to engage before the challenge fades in popularity. Many of these dares existed before they became video phenomena, but their documentation affords a wider audience and the promise of potential virality.

## Sync-Along

Sync-Along videos, typically performed solo or created through editing, feature people, animals, or objects lip syncing, dancing, or otherwise moving to synchronized music or other recognizable audio. Some sync-along videos, like many created on platforms Vine and DubSmash, find comedy in unexpected combinations of tightly synchronized motion and sound. Other sync-along videos, often found on musical.ly, place a focus squarely on the music as creators lip sync or dance to their favorite songs.

# Video Games

The computer revolution created video games and the internet, and their cultures are deeply intertwined. Since the web's inception, video game enthusiasts have recorded and shared their play online to document, perform, and socialize.

## Let's Play

Let's Play videos are screen recordings of video game play accompanied by audio (and sometimes video) of their players. Early Let's Play videos were minimally edited for efficiency; later videos introduced heavier editing to showcase the personalities of their players. The defining quality of the Let's Play video is its focus on the subjective experience of the player, produced with a casual or playful tone in conversation with an assumed audience that feels like spending time with friends. While Let's Play videos are not primarily instructional or educational in nature, they can be useful tools for education and criticism.

## Demonstration

Video game demonstrations often appropriate or subvert the original game, but they do not tell a story or otherwise require a suspension of disbelief. Early recordings of speedruns, in which players complete games as quickly as possible, allowed viewers to watch and learn from top players. As games and player behavior evolved, these videos exhibited other skills and creative labor like pacifist runs (in which the player completes a game without killing anyone), mods (modifications that alter the appearance or behavior of a game), and elaborate creations built within a game's world.

## Machinima

Machinima, a portmanteau of "machine" and "cinema", is a method for making animated films with video game software. Early machinima films were recorded as light-weight "demo files" that were considerably smaller than video files, allowing Machinima to propagate online well before sharing video was feasible. Machinima creators use video games for theatrical rather than competitive purposes, producing music videos, episodic comedy sketches, parodies, dramas, and even live talk shows. Machinima typically responds to the stories, settings, and characters of its source material: most machinima involves combat because the games that afford machinima are about combat.
